As of 1600 GMT, 3 May 2009, 18 countries have officially reported 898 cases of influenza A (H1N1) infection. Mexico has reported 506 confirmed human cases of infection, including 19 deaths. The higher number of cases from Mexico in the past 48 hours reflects ongoing testing of previously collected specimens. The United States Government has reported 226 laboratory confirmed human cases, including one death. Officers were called to the Costello Palace Hotel in the Finsbury area of north London on Sunday morning after the two bodies were discovered. "The bodies remain at the scene. We await confirmation regarding the cause of death," a police spokeswoman said. Firefighters were also called to the hotel and were treating it as a "chemical incident".

### **Al-Qaeda remains greatest terrorist threat: report**

In an annual report on terrorism, the State Department said "Al-Qaeda remained the greatest terrorist threat to the United States and its partners" even though its structures have weakened and public support has waned. And it warned that Al-Qaeda "has reconstituted some of its pre-9/11 operational capabilities" by using the Pakistan border areas, replacing key leaders, and restoring some "central control" by its top leadership. The report said that since the September 11 attacks, Al-Qaeda (AQ) and its allies have moved from Afghanistan into Pakistan where they have built "a safe haven to hide, train terrorists, communicate with followers, plot attacks, and send fighters to support the insurgency in Afghanistan."...

### **H1N1 Flu Outbreak Update**

#### **H1N1 Flu Outbreak - USA**

The H1N1 Flu outbreak continues to increase in the United States as well as internationally. On May 3, 2009, the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) reported 226 laboratory-confirmed cases in 30 states. There are 748 additional probable cases in the United States in 42 states

and Washington, D.C. There have been 30 hospitalizations among confirmed cases and one fatality (child in Texas). As of May 2, 2009, 434 schools in 18 states were closed due to confirmed or probable cases that have impacted a cumulative of 245,000 students and 15,544 teachers. California and Texas have issued States of Emergency. Florida, Iowa, Nebraska, Wisconsin, and Maryland have declared Public Health Emergencies.

### **H1N1 Flu Outbreak – International**

As of 4:00 p.m. EDT, May 3, 2009, according to the World Health Organization (WHO), 18 countries have officially reported 898 confirmed cases of infection. Mexico has reported 506 confirmed cases of infection, including 19 deaths. The higher number of cases from Mexico in the past 48 hours reflects ongoing testing of previously collected specimens.

The following countries have reported laboratory confirmed cases with no deaths - Austria (1), Canada (85), China, Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (1), Costa Rica (1), Denmark (1), France (2), Germany (8), Ireland (1), Israel (3), Italy (1), Netherlands (1), New Zealand (4), Republic of Korea (1), Spain (40), Switzerland (1), and the United Kingdom (15). The Pan American Health Organization / World Health Organization (PAHO/WHO) pandemic alert level remains at Phase 5.

FEMA Leadership is monitoring the current situation, participating in conferences and planning sessions to respond to the needs of state and local agencies. FEMA NRCC is maintaining contact with

- The United States Embassy will reopen on Wednesday, May 6, 2009. As a precautionary measure only, the Embassy in Mexico City decided to suspend processing of non-immigrant visa appointments scheduled for May 6 through May 8, 2009. (*DOS, HHS SOC, CDC, PAHO/WHO*)

### **CDC continues to take aggressive action to respond to an expanding outbreak caused by novel H1N1 flu**

#### **CDC's response goals are to:**

1. Reduce transmission and illness severity, and
2. Provide information to help health care providers, public health officials and the public address the challenges posed by this emergency. CDC continues to issue and update interim guidance daily in response to the rapidly evolving situation. CDC will issue updated interim guidance for clinicians on how to identify and care for people who are sick with novel H1N1 flu illness. This guidance will provide priorities for testing and treatment for novel H1N1 flu infection. The priority use for influenza antiviral drugs during this outbreak will be to treat people with severe flu illness. On May 3, CDC is scheduled to complete deployment of 25

percent of the supplies in the Strategic National Stockpile (SNS) to all states in the continental United States. These supplies and medicines will help states and U.S. territories respond to the outbreak. In addition, the Federal Government and manufacturers have begun the process of developing a vaccine against the novel H1N1 flu virus. Response actions are aggressive, but they may vary across states and communities depending on local circumstances. Communities, businesses, places of worship, schools and individuals can all take action to slow the spread of this outbreak. People who are sick are urged to stay home from work or school and to avoid contact with others, except to seek medical care. This action can avoid spreading illness further.

### **CDC respirator use guidance:**

"The prioritization of respirator use during a pandemic remains unchanged: N95 (or higher) respirators should be worn during medical activities that have a high likelihood of generating infectious respiratory aerosols, for which respirators (not surgical masks) offer the most appropriate protection for health care personnel. Use of N95 respirators is also prudent for health care personnel during other direct patient care activities (e.g., examination, bathing, feeding) and for support staff who may have direct contact with pandemic influenza patients. If N95 or other types of respirators are not available, surgical masks provide benefit against large-droplet exposure and should be worn for all health care activities involving patients with confirmed or suspected pandemic influenza. Measures should be employed to minimize the number of personnel required to come in contact with suspected or confirmed pandemic influenza patients"

### **In conspiracy trial, dark tale emerges of jihad training**

NEW YORK — Speaking publicly for the first time, former Seattle resident James Ujaama testified Tuesday about his efforts in 1999 to create a terrorist training camp in rural Oregon for would-be jihad warriors wishing to take up the fight against the U.S.-backed Northern Alliance in Afghanistan. Among the instructors would be Oussama Kassir, a Swedish jihadist who once bragged he had been a bodyguard for Osama bin Laden. Ujaama, appearing thin and graying and dressed in oversized prison overalls, took the witness stand in the terrorism conspiracy trial of Kassir, who is accused of traveling from London to the barren ranch in Bly, Ore., to help set up the training camp. Ujaama is a key prosecution witness in Kassir's federal trial, having already pleaded guilty to conspiracy charges. He told the U.S. District Court jury in Manhattan that he hopes to get a "significant reduction" in his sentence in exchange for his testimony against Kassir. He faces up to 30 years. Several other former and current Seattle witnesses also testified that they met Kassir and another man, Harroon Aswat, either at the Bly property or at the now-defunct Masjid Dar-us-Salaam mosque in Seattle's Central Area where the men stayed for about two months in the fall of 1999. Their testimony paints a darker portrait of those events than previously acknowledged by authorities or those involved.... Ujaama took the stand late in the afternoon and was walked through his conversion to Islam in the late 1980s and how he gravitated to Muslim preacher Abu Hamza al-Masri through a series of other increasingly radical Islamic preachers. Abu Hamza is serving a seven-year sentence in Britain for inciting his followers to kill nonbelievers and has been indicted in the U.S. on 11 charges related to the planned development of the Bly site and for sending cash and volunteers to support al-Qaida and the Taliban...
